CyberFirst Adventurers

CyberFirst Adventurers is a free one-day development course aimed at students who have not yet made their GCSE choices (11 to 14 year-olds*) and their parents/guardians.

The course is designed to showcase the varied roles and jobs that both exist and involve the use of technology in the workplace, to enthuse and inspire the participants into an interest in technology. It is also designed to counter the stereotype that computer science is a subject that only leads to jobs in programming and coding. The course is aimed at students who have not yet made their GCSE choices, so that they get the opportunity to see how studying computer science could potentially augment and enhance their future career prospects.

As student's GCSE choices are often made in conjunction with their parents/guardians, teachers and careers advisors, the course is designed to involve these adults too, so that they can see the benefit of students studying computer science, as well as how positive a mutual experience it can be.

Our CyberFirst Adventurers courses run on a Saturday between 10:00 and 15:30 at selected UK mainland universities and colleges. Each event consists of four themed modules offering interactive, hands on, self-guided, exploratory learning that reduces the amount of time spent in traditional instructor led presentations to the very minimum. The four career based themes covered are:

Problem solving and teamworking in a technical environment, medicine, web development/art and design and sports science - all highlighting the importance and opportunities of a career in cyber security.
